The Zimbabwe Electoral Commission (ZEC) hereby invites applications from observers and the media for accreditation to observe the inspection of the Provisional Voters` Roll. Those who were accredited to observe the Biometric Voter Registration (BVR) exercise need not reapply as the validity of their accreditation has been extended to cover the inspection period.

The accreditation of successful applicants shall be conducted between 8 am and 5 pm at the venues to be advised commencing on **10 May 2018** up to **29 May 2018**.

- Zimbabwean local media practitioners accredited with the Zimbabwe Media Commission – US\$10
- Media practitioners from the continent of Africa - \$20
